

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at <u>www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2</u>. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 27 March 2019, we carried out an inspection which resulted in an outcome judgement of Inadequate. Please see report published on Ofsted website. We served a Welfare Requirements Notice (WRN). This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the actions within the timescales set out. We carried out an unannounced monitoring visit on 13 May 2019 to monitor the WRN's and check the provider's compliance with requirements. We were satisfied with the action taken by the provider. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

The provider will be re-inspected within six months of the last inspection. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
