Summary of key findings for parents

This provision meets requirements

- Leaders and staff ensure secure safeguarding procedures. They understand the signs that indicate a child may be at risk of harm. They know the procedures to follow if they have a concern about a child's welfare or the behaviour of another adult. There are effective procedures in place for the recruitment, induction and training of staff.
- Leaders and staff know how to plan activities and offer a wide variety of resources for children's play. They recognise the importance of working in partnership with the host school and parents to ensure continuity of care and learning for children.
- Leaders and staff are aware of how to help children understand behaviour expectations. They know how to support children's independence and allow them to make choices about what they want to do in the club.
- Leaders and staff understand the importance of supporting children's good health. They know to provide children with opportunities to be physically active. There are good procedures in place to ensure children's medical needs and allergies are met.
- Leaders understand the importance of making sure staff are well supported in their roles. Staff have regular supervision and frequent opportunities for training in order to enhance their existing knowledge and increase their personal effectiveness.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector spoke with the provider about how they would organise the routine to meet the needs of the children in the early years range.
- The inspector viewed the areas of the premises used and assessed the safety and suitability of those areas.
- The inspector looked at a range of documentation, including the club's policies and procedures and recruitment systems, and checked evidence relating to the suitability of staff.
- The inspector discussed with the provider and staff how they ensure the safeguarding and welfare requirements are met.
