

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

We publish details of any actions we take, or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with legal requirements.

We publish details on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 18th April 2019 we carried out an inspection visit and served a welfare requirement notice. On 14th May 2019 a monitoring visit took place. We found that the provider had promptly met all of the actions raised. The provider has completed safeguarding training with staff, reviewed accident and medication policies and ensured that all attendance records are completed accurately. In addition, the provider has put into place robust monitoring systems to ensure staff are effectively deployed and effective supervision processes are in place. Furthermore, the provider has reviewed risk assessment procedures and ensures that hazards to children are swiftly identified and addressed. The provider ensures that all medications are stored securely and safely. This means that they have met their legal responsibility as set out in the early years foundation stage welfare requirements.

The provider remains registered with Ofsted.
