Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at

www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. On 20 March 2019, we carried out an inspection. Details of this report may be found on the Ofsted website. Following the inspection, we served a Welfare Requirements Notice (WRN). This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the actions within the timescales set out. We carried out an unannounced visit on 29 April 2019 and found the provider had not met five of the nine actions in the WRN served. We served a further WRN notice which requires the provider to meet the actions by 31 May 2019.

ensure vetting and recruitment procedures are robust to ensure the suitability of staff

ensure the deputy manager is capable and has the necessary experience and skills to take charge in the absence of the manager

ensure all staff receive effective induction; monitoring, coaching and support they need to be competent to carry out their roles and responsibilities, including their role as a key person

ensure staff, including leaders and managers, undertake appropriate training and professional development opportunities, to offer learning and development experiences for children to help them progress continually

assign each child a key person to support children to settle, become familiar with the setting
