

## **Compliance action taken for childcare provision**

### **Summary of outcome**

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at [www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2](http://www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2). If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. On 4 December 2018 we received information which raised our concerns about, recruitment, safeguarding, behaviour management and how children with special educational needs and/or disabilities are cared for. We liaised with the provider who gave detailed information as requested. On 10 May 2019 we conducted an announced visit. We found children receive positive interaction from staff and behaviour is managed appropriately. We found the required information is obtained when recruiting staff. Staff receive training both in-house and from external providers. The provider took steps to ensure those managers involved in recruitment have up-to-date training. That staff delivering in-house training also have up-to-date training so that current knowledge is shared.

The provider will be able to provide further information about this. We will continue to monitor the provider. The provider remains registered with Ofsted.

### **Publication of compliance action**

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
