- The childminder understands how to provide a suitable learning environment, activities and resources for children. She knows how to monitor their progress and plan for their next stages, including their move to school.
- The childminder understands the importance of working in partnership with parents, to help keep them informed and share information about their child.
- The childminder understands how to manage children's behaviour appropriately and protect children's welfare and care needs. She knows how to provide a healthy diet and recognises the importance of regular physical play.
- The childminder understands the importance of reflective practice to make ongoing improvements.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The childminder registered in 1992 and lives in the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea. She operates all year round from 6.30am to 6.30pm, Monday to Sunday, except for bank holidays and family holidays. The childminder offers occasional overnight care.
