

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2

If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 23 January 2019 we received concerns that this provider was not meeting some of these requirements.

On 21 May 2019 we visited the provider to check they are meeting requirements of their registration. Following the visit, we served a notice to improve that asks the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Actions needed by 21 June 2019:

improve knowledge and understanding in relation to what changes must be notified to Ofsted;

ensure all staff are fully aware about the setting's fire evacuation policy and procedures to be able to keep children safe in an emergency.

The provider remains registered with Ofsted.



Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
