

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. On 16 May 2019 we received concerns that the provider was not meeting requirements. We served a welfare requirements notice on 23 May 2019. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the actions below by 4 June 2019. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

- ensure that all staff have an understanding of the safeguarding policy and the procedures, with particular reference to recognising signs of possible abuse and neglect and their awareness of the potential safeguarding concerns in relation to extreme views and behaviours
- ensure all staff, including the designated lead for safeguarding, understand the safeguarding policy and procedures, particularly if there is an allegation against a member of staff
- ensure that staff are confident in gathering the information they need to make informed decisions about potential safeguarding concern, particularly in relation to injuries that children sustain away from the setting
- ensure Ofsted are notified of any allegations of harm or abuse by any person looking after children within the required time frame
- ensure Ofsted are notified of any significant event which is likely to affect the suitability of the early years provider or any person who care for, or is in regular contact with, children on the premises to look after children.

We visited the provider on 3 June 2019 and are satisfied with the action taken. The provider remains registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services



we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
