

Complaint about childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. On 13 November 2018 we received concerns that this provider was not meeting some of these requirements.

We carried out an unannounced visit and found that there had been no breaches to the requirements that had been raised in the concern.

Although it was not part of the original concern, we found that there had been changes to the health of the provider and another adult living at the premises. We asked them both to complete updated health checks and found that they both remain suitable.

The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of complaints

We publish details of complaints made against childminders, home childcarers and childcare providers where we or the provider have taken action in order to meet legal requirements.

We publish details of complaints for five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
