

Complaint about childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. On 07 June 2019, we received a concern. We conducted an unannounced visit where we issued them with a notice to improve. This requires the provider to take the action below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

The provider has taken appropriate action. The provider remains registered with Ofsted.
