

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 20 May 2019, we carried out an inspection which judged that the overall effectiveness of the setting was 'inadequate' and did not meet requirements of registration. Following our inspection, we served a welfare requirements notice on the provider that required them to take action to meet requirements. The full details of these breaches are contained in the published inspection report.

On 17 June 2019, we conducted an unannounced monitoring visit to the setting to assess compliance with the welfare requirement notices and notices to improve. We found the provider had taken appropriate action to ensure all requirements were met. The provider will be able to give you further information about action they have taken. Ofsted will conduct a further unannounced full inspection in six months' time to monitor the quality of the provision.

The provider remains registered with Ofsted.
