

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. On 25 February 2019, we received concerns that this provider was not meeting some of these requirements.

We have served a notice to improve. This notice requires the provider to take the action below within the timescale set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Action needed – by 18 April 2019:

Ensure that your medication records are completed accurately and that they include details of the last time that medicine has been administered to a child and details of who has administered this. Further ensure that your medication policy is updated to reflect these changes in record keeping.

We also found that the provider had failed to notify Ofsted of some significant events that were likely to affect their suitability to look after children. This is also a breach of requirements. We decided not to take any action on this occasion as the provider confirmed their understanding of the requirements regarding notification in the future.

We have received a response from the provider confirming that they have completed the action. We are satisfied that the provider has taken the appropriate steps. The provider remains registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
