

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

Early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, (EYFS) which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

At an inspection on 9 May 2019, we found that this provider was not meeting some of these requirements. Following the inspection we served a Welfare Requirements Notice (WRN). This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Actions needed to be completed by 7 June 2019:

- ensure that staff performance is closely monitored and identifies how staff can improve on the quality of their interactions with children
- ensure that robust, safer recruitment processes are in place, which verify staff suitability and include the recording of all essential information from DBS checks
- provide Ofsted with the necessary information to complete suitability checks for all persons involved with the playgroup and to monitor this process
- follow hygienic practices, with particular regard to handwashing.

We visited the provider on 11 June 2019 to monitor compliance with the WRN. The provider demonstrated how relevant processes, practices and monitoring arrangements had been reviewed and implemented. We were satisfied with the actions the provider had taken. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
