

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. On 13 June 2019, we received concerns in relation to safety and well-being. On 19 June 2019, we completed an unannounced visit and issued a notice to improve that requires the provider to take the action below within the timescales set out.

Actions needed:

ensure that training and professional development experiences extend knowledge and skills, in relation to managing older children's behaviour more effectively, by 26 July 2019

engage more effectively with staff and teachers at other settings children also attend to ensure that children's individual needs are met, by 26 July 2019.

The provider responded in writing to the notice to improve and we are satisfied with the action taken to meet requirements. The provider remains registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
