

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. On 3 July we identified concerns that this provider was not meeting some of these requirements. We have served a Welfare Requirements Notice. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out.

ensure that ongoing concerns regarding children's welfare are reported to the appropriate agencies in a timely manner, in line with Local Safeguarding Children Board guidance by 5 July 2019

ensure the person responsible for safeguarding children has the appropriate knowledge and skills to be able to confidently identify and report possible child protection concerns by 12 July 2019

ensure records regarding children's welfare are available at all times by 5 July 2019.

We carried out a regulatory visit on 15 July 2019 and are now satisfied with the actions taken by the provider to ensure they are meeting the requirements of registration.

The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
