

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. On 13 June 2019, we inspected this provider and found they were not meeting some of these requirements. We served the provider with a Welfare Requirements Notice (WRN). This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Actions needed by 28 June 2019:

- ensure the nursery's safeguarding policy and procedures include a clear explanation of the action to take in the event of an allegation against staff, in line with Local Safeguarding Children Board (LSCB) procedures
- make sure all staff understand the procedures to follow to safeguard children, particularly in relation to the action to take if there is an allegation against a member of staff, in line with LSCB procedures
- provide children with food that is healthy, balanced and nutritious
- ensure information and records about children, particularly when there are concerns about their welfare, are sufficiently detailed in order for them to be shared with other professionals, if necessary, and keep children safe.

On 15 July 2019, we visited the nursery to check the provider's compliance with the WRN. We found that the provider has taken appropriate action to meet the requirements. The provider will be re-inspected within six months of the date of the last inspection. The provider remains registered with Ofsted.
