

## **Compliance action taken for childcare provision**

## **Summary of outcome**

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at <a href="https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2">www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2</a>. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. On 29 May 2019 we conducted a full inspection following a number of concerns raised to Ofsted. We judged the provision to be inadequate because it was not meeting some of these requirements. We have issued a Welfare Requirements Notice. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

## Actions needed

ensure all staff fully understand the safeguarding policies and procedures, and their responsibilities to respond appropriately to the signs of possible abuse, taking appropriate action to keep children safe by 21 June 2019

ensure that all staff implement the policy and procedures for the safe use of mobile phones and cameras at the setting by 21 June 2019

ensure that all checks have been completed relating to vetting processes and the suitability of staff and this is documented accurately by 21 June 2019

implement effective systems for risk assessment to ensure that risks are removed or minimised by 21 June 2019

maintain an accurate daily record of each child's hours of attendance by 21 June 2019

provide children with meals that are nutritiously balanced to support their health by 21 June 2019

ensure staff manage children's behaviour effectively to help them to understand the reasons for rules and how their actions affect others by 21 June 2019

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implement effective arrangements for the monitoring, support and coaching of staff, to identify and act on weaknesses in practice, to improve the quality of teaching and learning by 21 June 2019.

We made an unannounced visit on 24 June 2019. We were satisfied with the action taken by the provider.
