

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at <u>www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2</u>. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. On 18 June 2019 we received a concern that this provider was not meeting some of these requirements.

We served a Welfare Requirements Notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give the parents information about this.

Action required by 26 July 2019

ensure unvetted individuals, including visitors are supervised at all times and that staff are aware of these supervision arrangements

ensure all staff working or volunteering at the setting, fully understand their roles and responsibilities

ensure that all complaints are identified appropriately to ensure the outcome of any investigation is notified to the complainant within 28 days and that all records are made available to Ofsted when requested.

The provider has taken appropriate steps and we are satisfied that the provider is meeting the requirements of registration. The provider remains registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply



with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
