

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. On 28 June 2019 we received information of concern from an external agency. The provider also notified us of the concern relating to a safeguarding matter. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the early years foundation stage welfare requirements to notify Ofsted of any information affecting the suitability of adults working with children. We have served a notice to improve. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out.

Actions needed by 2 August 2019

ensure children's behaviour is managed consistently using positive strategies which does not adversely affect their well-being

ensure ratios are always maintained, including on outings, to promote children's welfare and safety

The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider responded satisfactorily. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
