

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. On 18 July 2019 we received a notification from the provider. This notification means that the provider met their statutory duty to let Ofsted know of any significant events. On 29 July 2019, we completed an unannounced visit and issued a notice to improve that requires the provider to take the action below within the timescales set out.

Actions needed:

take all necessary steps to keep children safe and well, particularly on outings, by 12 August 2019

ensure that staff are deployed effectively to supervise children and meet their needs at all times, particularly on outings, by 12 August 2019

take all reasonable steps to ensure that children are not able to leave the premises unsupervised, with particular regard to outings, by 12 August 2019

ensure that effective risk assessments are undertaken to identify, remove, minimise and manage risks to children's safety, with particular regard to outings, by 12 August 2019.

The provider remains registered with Ofsted.

The provider responded to our notice to improve by 2 August 2019. We found that the provider had taken appropriate action.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
