Summary of key findings for parents

This provision meets requirements

- The provider has robust recruitment and vetting procedures in place to help ensure that all staff are suitable to work with children. New staff work through an in-depth induction process. This helps them to fully understand their role and responsibilities.
- The manager ensures that staff understand how to protect children's welfare. For example, that they know how to keep children safe and are aware of the procedures to follow to report any concerns relating to their safety.
- Through discussion, the manager shows that she understands how to plan an exciting range of games and activities which consider children's interests and wishes, both inside and outdoors.
- The manager understands the importance of helping children to develop healthy lifestyles. For example, they promote healthy eating and provide many opportunities for children to be active outdoors.
- The provider, manager and staff regularly reflect on their practice and actively seek the views of children and parents. They incorporate their ideas into practice, for example by adding new activities that children request.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector spoke to the manager about her understanding of the requirements of the early years foundation stage.
- The inspector looked at the evidence of the suitability of adults who work on the premises and a selection of policies, safety procedures and required documentation.
- The inspector discussed with the manager the activities, resources and equipment that are available for children to use.
- The inspector took into account the provider's reflections on practice, ongoing action plans and staff's ongoing professional development opportunities.
