

Complaint about childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 29 July 2019 we received concerns that this provider was not meeting some of these requirements. We visited the provider to discuss the concerns and have issued a Notice to Improve. This is a notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. We will monitor the provider's response. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Action required;

Gain a secure knowledge and understanding of safeguarding policies and procedures in order to act quickly and decisively to keep children safe from harm

by 19 August 2019.

The provider has addressed the above action within the set timescale. The provider remains suitable for registration.

Publication of complaints

We publish details of complaints made against childminders, home childcarers and childcare providers where we or the provider have taken action in order to meet legal requirements.

We publish details of complaints for five years commencing on the date we complete our



investigation.
