Summary of key findings for parents

This provision meets requirements

- Since the previous inspection, the childminder has reviewed her behaviour policies and procedures and knows how to use them consistently to help children understand how to behave well. She also shares her rules with parents and children so that they know what is expected.
- The childminder knows how to help children adopt healthy lifestyles. For example, she provides healthy meals and helps children to understand the importance of washing their hands to reduce the risk of infection. She knows that she needs to provide opportunities to help children to develop their physical skills.
- The childminder risk assesses her home regularly to help keep children safe.
- The childminder has a valid paediatric first-aid certificate and knows how to meet the needs of children.
- The childminder knows how to work in partnership with parents. For example, she keeps parents regularly informed about their children's learning and development and offers them guidance on how to support their children at home and beyond.
- The childminder attends courses and liaises with outside professionals to strengthen her childminding skills.
- The childminder considers the comments and suggestions of parents and others to help her to improve her service.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector had a tour of the areas of the premises used for childminding with the childminder.
- The inspector checked the childminder's policies and procedures, including safeguarding requirements.
- The inspector discussed with the childminder her knowledge and skills relating to the early years foundation stage.
