

Complaint about childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. On 15 and 18 July and on 5 and 9 August 2019 we received concerns that this

matters right. On 15 and 18 July and on 5 and 9 August 2019 we received concerns that this provider was not meeting some of these requirements. We sent the provider a notice to improve which asks the provider to take action. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Action needed:

ensure that children are protected from the harmful effects of the sun, for example, by ensuring that they apply sun screen.

The provider responded to the notice to improve.

The provider has now resigned their registration.

We publish details of complaints made against childminders, home childcarers and childcare providers where we or the provider have taken action in order to meet legal requirements.
