

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. On 12 August 2019 we received concerns that the provider was not meeting some of these requirements. The provider notified us on 23 July 2019 of the event. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the early years foundation stage welfare requirements to notify Ofsted of any significant events.

We visited the provider on 21 August 2019 and asked the provider to take appropriate action to ensure the security and safety of children.

We issued a welfare requirement notice that requires the provider to carry out the action below within the timescale set out.

Actions required by 2 September 2019

carry out regular reviews of risk assessments to ensure they are effective in minimising risk, specifically when new procedures have been implemented following a serious incident or accident

ensure staffing arrangements meet the needs of children and ensure their safety, specifically by effectively deploying staff so that all children are supervised well

make sure staff understand and know how to act in the case of accidents and emergencies, and seek help from external agencies promptly to ensure children's welfare and safety

ensure managers and leaders know the correct procedures for notifying other agencies when there are serious accidents or injuries at the provision

We carried out a compliance visit on 4 September 2019 and are satisfied with the action the provider took to meet the Welfare Requirements Notice.

The provider remains registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
