- The children are provided with a suitable environment, activities and resources. The manager and staff understand how to complement the learning and activities children undertake in school.
- The manager and staff are aware of the importance of working closely with parents and others involved in the care of children to ensure children's needs are recognised and met.
- The manager and staff carry out self-evaluation to identify areas to strengthen. They regularly gather the views of parents and children. Their ideas are incorporated into the plans for future development and improvements at the club.
- The manager and staff understand how to support children to develop healthy lifestyles. They provide healthy snacks and opportunities for children to have daily physical exercise.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. Naphill and Walters Ash Out of School Club registered in 2002 and operates from within Naphill and Walters Ash School, on the outskirts of High Wycombe, Buckinghamshire. The club opens each weekday during term time, before school from 8am to 8.45am and after school from 3.15pm to 6pm. The holiday club operates in most school holidays from 8am to 6pm and is open to all children living in the local area. A total of nine staff work with the children. Of these, one member of staff holds a relevant childcare qualification at level 4 and five staff hold a relevant childcare qualification at level 3.
