

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 12 July 2019, we received information which raised concerns that the provider was not meeting some of these requirements. We visited the provider and found they had taken appropriate action to rectify non-compliance with reporting safeguarding concerns. However, during the visit we found further weaknesses. We have served a notice to improve that requires the provider to take the actions set out below within the identified timescales. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Action needed:

3.77 ensure Ofsted are notified of changes to the individuals who are partners or directors. To be met by 28-08-2019.

3.9 ensure there are effective systems in place to confirm that any person working on the premises who doesn't care for children is suitable. To be met by 09-09-2019.

We are satisfied with the action taken by the provider. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years

commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
