

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework-2.If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 3 May 2019, we received concerns that this provider was not meeting some of these requirements. At a visit on 11 June 2019 it was found that there are currently no security measures in place to prevent unauthorised adults entering the nursery room. It was found that children were not being adequately supervised when using the toilet facilities within the school and that the provider does not always ensure the ratios of children to adult are met.

We issued a notice to notice. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out

- improve the security arrangements to prevent unauthorised persons entering the nursery room by 30 August 2019
- improve the risk assessment for the arrangement of the toileting facilities to ensure children are not left unsupervised at any time by 30 August 2019
- ensure there is at least one member of staff for every eight children for children aged three and over at all times by 25 June 2019.

The provider suitably addressed the actions and made improvements.

The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action



We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.
