

## **Compliance action taken for childcare provision**

## **Summary of outcome**

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at

www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. On 22 May 2019 the provider was inspected, and they received a judgement of inadequate. We served a welfare requirement notice. We carried out a monitoring visit and found that the provider had not taken the sufficient steps to meet all of the actions in the notice. We have served a further welfare requirement notice that requires the provider to meet the actions below within the timescale set. The provider will be able to give parents information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Action to be taken by 22 July 2019:

ensure that staff and management understand and follow safeguarding procedures, to refer any concerns to the relevant agencies without delay

ensure that the correct procedures are followed to act on allegations raised, in accordance to the local safeguarding children board

We carried out a monitoring visit on 25 July 2019 and found that the provider had met the actions. We issued a notice to improve due to further breaches to the requirements, which requires the provider to take the action below within the timescale set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Action to be taken by 5 August 2019:

take action to ensure that fire safety requirements are met

ensure that risk assessments are used effectively to keep children safe, with particular regard to fire safety requirements

We are satisfied with the action the provider has taken. The provider remains registered with Ofsted.
