

Complaint about childcare provision

Summary of outcome

'All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at

www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. On 17 September 2019 we received concerns that this provider was not meeting some of these requirements, this was with specific regard to accident reporting. We made a visit to the provider. They have taken action to address gaps in their reporting procedures for accidents, to ensure that information is shared with parents/carers in the event of an accident to a child at the nursery. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.'
