

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at

www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 31 January 2019 we carried out a visit to monitor that the provider had taken steps to meet actions set out in the Welfare Requirements Notice served following the inspection on 16 October 2019. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the actions within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. At the visit, we found that the provider had taken appropriate action to put some of the matters right. However, we found that risk assessments for the premises were still not effective, as there were a number of hazards still present; not enough has been done to ensure that the key person system is effective; staff supervision meetings had not been instigated and information contained in the safeguarding procedure was incorrect and was not relevant to the setting. We served a further Welfare Requirements Notice and monitored this at the inspection conducted on 16 April 2019. We found that the provider had taken appropriate action to meet requirements.

Since this inspection the provider has resigned their registration with Ofsted. The provider is no longer registered with Ofsted.
