

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. On 16 August 2019 we inspected the provider and found they were not meeting some of these requirements. We served a welfare requirements notice. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Actions needed:

- implement effective risk assessments so that all risks and hazards are minimised to ensure children's safety by 2 September 2019
- keep an accurate daily record of the names of the children being cared for on the premises and their hours of attendance by 2 September 2019
- ensure that you gather all of the required information for each child in your care, including who has parental responsibility for each child and emergency contact details for parents and carers by 2 September 2019
- keep a written record each time a medicine is administered to a child, including the type and dose of medication given by 2 September 2019

The provider has taken appropriate steps to meet the actions. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
