

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. On 8 July 2019 we inspected the provider and found they were not meeting some of these requirements. We served a Welfare Requirements Notice. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Actions needed:

ensure that staff understand the safeguarding policy and procedures and know how to respond to safeguarding concerns about children in a timely and appropriate way by 2 September 2019

ensure the procedures set out in your safeguarding policy are implemented effectively so that any safeguarding concerns about children are reported to the appropriate agency without delay by 2 September 2019

ensure supervisions of staff allow a robust discussion about any concerns they may have about children so that they are adequately safeguarded by 2 September 2019

provide Ofsted with the required information regarding new committee members, to enable full suitability checks to be carried out by 2 September 2019

We completed a monitoring visit to the provider and found that they were not meeting some of the requirements. We served another Welfare Requirements Notice. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Actions needed:

provide Ofsted with the required information regarding new committee members, to enable full suitability checks to be carried out by 29 November 2019

ensure supervisions of staff allow a robust discussion about any concerns they may have about children so that they are adequately safeguarded by 29 November 2019

ensure the procedures set out in your safeguarding policy are implemented effectively so that any safeguarding concerns about children are reported to the appropriate agency without delay by 29 November 2019

implement robust systems to ensure the effective and timely completion of records maintained of existing injuries to children by 29 November 2019

ensure you are alert to any issues of concerns in the child's life at home or elsewhere. This is with particular regard to obtaining information as to whether a child is involved with child protection agencies by 29 November 2019
