Summary of key findings

This provision does not meet requirements

- The childminder is unable to provide evidence of her first-aid training.
- The childminder has failed to ensure that she has public liability insurance.
- The childminder has failed to provide Ofsted with enough information to ensure all required suitability checks are completed for all persons living on the premises.
- The childminder does not ensure that all safeguarding and welfare requirements are met, including safeguarding training.
- The childminder has a good understanding of the learning and development requirements and how to use these in her planning to support children's next steps.
- The childminder has a clear knowledge of how to promote positive behaviour so that children can learn to have respect and consideration for others.
- The childminder recognises the importance of working in partnership with parents to support children's individual care and learning needs throughout the day.
- The childminder explains how she intends to deliver a broad curriculum based on children's interests.
- The childminder understands how to promote children's well-being. She demonstrates, through discussion, how she will provide daily opportunities for children to access fresh air, and she understands the importance of a healthy diet.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

What does the setting need to do to improve?

To meet the requirements of the early years foundation stage and Childcare Register the provider must:
