

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. On 22 August 2019 we received concerns that this provider was not meeting some of these requirements. We have issued a notice to improve. This is a notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out. The provider responded appropriately to the actions set. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. We received further information on 15 October 2019 about an incident where a child left the playgroup unsupervised. The provider has improved the collection procedures to ensure this does not happen again. No further action was taken. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Actions needed

ensure all staff understand how to implement a safeguarding policy in line with local safeguarding partnership procedures, with particular focus on dealing appropriately with allegations against members of staff – due by 25 October 2019

improve understanding of the significant events which Ofsted are required to be notified of.
– due by 25 October 2019

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
