Summary of key findings

This provision meets requirements

- The childminder has a clear understanding of her responsibility to safeguard children. She explains how she would know how to identify any potential signs of abuse and she demonstrates a good understanding of local reporting procedures.
- The childminder describes how she intends to observe children and assess their development. She explains how she plans to use the information to monitor children's progress and to plan challenging activities for them which incorporate their interests.
- The childminder recognises the importance of working with parents and teachers at the schools children attend to contribute to building on children's existing skills.
- The childminder demonstrates that she understands how to support children's emotional well-being. She discusses a range of appropriate behaviour management strategies.
- The childminder understands how to promote children's physical well-being and the importance of helping children to enjoy a balanced and varied diet. She would ensure children have regular opportunities to be active and play outside.
- The childminder discusses how she gathers the views of parents to help to reflect on her practice in order to continually improve and develop.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.
