

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. On 2 August 2019, we received information that the provider was not meeting some of these requirements. We have issued a welfare requirements notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with

Action needed:

Ofsted.

3.25 Staff qualifications, training, support and skills

ensure that at least one person who has a current paediatric first aid is on the premises and available at all times when children are present, by 20 September 2019

3.50 Accident or injury

keep an accurate written record of accidents or injuries and first aid treatment and provide parents with the correct information about any accident or injury sustained by the child, by 2 September 2019

3.76 Information about the provider

keep a daily record of the names of the children being cared for on the premises, their hours of attendance and the names of each child's key person, by 2 September 2019



3.68 Information and records

maintain all required records to ensure the safe and efficient management of the setting, and to ensure the needs of all children are met, by 2 September 2019.

We will continue to monitor the provider's compliance.

Action Taken:

We monitored the provider's compliance with these requirements on 26 September 2019. At the time of the visit the provider had addressed actions with regard to the accuracy of records that must be kept. On 28 October 2019 she provided confirmation that a staff member completed paediatric first-aid training on 4 October 2019. We are satisfied that the provider has taken appropriate steps to address the weaknesses in practice. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.



We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
