

## Compliance action taken for childcare provision

## **Summary of outcome**

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at <a href="https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework">www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework</a>.

If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. On 10 October 2019 we carried out a visit to the setting to monitor the action taken by the provider to meet the Welfare Requirements Notice which was served at the last inspection. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take action to meet requirements. The inspection report is available to view on the Ofsted website. We found during that visit that action has been taken to meet the Welfare Requirements Notice. However, we identified two additional breaches of the requirements. As a result, with served actions.

## Actions needed

ensure that all staff have a clear understand of their roles and responsibilities by 22 October 2019

have effective systems in place which ensures that practitioners are suitable to work with children, this is with particular regard to establishing any gaps in employment by 22 October 2019

The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

A suitable response to the actions was received. A full inspection will now take place to monitor all the actions.
