

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. On 1 October 2019 we conducted an inspection and found that this provider was not meeting some of these requirements. We issued a Welfare Requirement Notice. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Actions needed:

develop and implement effective systems so that any concerns about staff's suitability are robustly investigated to ensure that people looking after children are suitable to do so by 28 October 2019

ensure that records, which support the safe and efficient management of the setting, are easily accessible and available at all times by 28 October 2019

ensure that staff have the support and coaching they need to effectively manage any concerns about staff's suitability and to raise the quality of teaching to a consistently good level by 28 October 2019.

We made an unannounced visit on 4 November 2019 and found that the provider had met all the actions above.
