

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. On 14 October 2019, we received concerns that this provider was not meeting the requirements. On the 30 October 2019 we visited Little Potters Pre-school and found that not all of the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage' requirements were being met. We have issued a Welfare Requirements Notice. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.'

Actions needed

3.68 Information and records

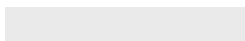
improve and maintain records to ensure the safe and efficient management of the setting by 15 November 2019

3.4 and 3.7 Child protection

ensure that you have regard to government's statutory guidance 'Working together to safeguard children 2015. Where there are concerns about children's safety and welfare you must notify agencies with statutory responsibilities without delay by 15 November 2019

3.6 Child protection

ensure all staff are trained to understand the safeguarding policy and procedures and that they have up to date knowledge of safeguarding issues. Ensure that staff identify signs of possible abuse and neglect at the earliest opportunity and respond in a timely and appropriate way by 15 November 2019.



A monitoring visit took place on 18 November to monitor compliance with the notice. The provider is meeting requirements.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
