Summary of key findings

This provision meets requirements

- The childminder clearly demonstrates that she understands her role to keep children safe. She knows the actions to follow if she has any concerns about children's welfare. The childminder ensures her home is clean and safe for children to play and learn in.
- The childminder understands the importance of working with parents and others involved with children to support continuity and consistency in their care and learning. She knows how to support children's learning and build on what they already know and can do. The childminder understands how to support children to develop the skills that will help them when it is time to move on to school.
- The childminder understands how to support children to develop positive attitudes and behaviour. She knows a range of strategies to help children to manage and resolve their own disputes.
- The childminder understands how to support children to make healthy choices, develop skills, such as independence, and promote their self-confidence and self-esteem.
- The childminder knows the importance of keeping her skills and knowledge current. She has clear plans for future developments.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.
