

Complaint about childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework-2.

If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 13 June and 25 September 2019 we received concerns that this provider was not meeting some of these requirements.

We have served a notice to improve. This notice requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescale set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Actions needed by 1 November 2019:

ensure risk assessments are robust and identify and minimise potential hazards, with particular regard to rat boxes and wheelie bins in the outside area

ensure that areas used for childcare are hygienically clean and well maintained.

Before we received a response to these actions the provider resigned the registration.

Publication of complaints

We publish details of complaints made against childminders, home childcarers and childcare providers where we or the provider have taken action in order to meet legal requirements.

We publish details of complaints for five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
