

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. On 26 November 2019 we received concerns that this provider was not meeting some of these requirements. We have served a notice to improve that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Actions needed:

ensure all staff have a secure understanding of the setting's safeguarding policy, including the procedures to follow and current legislation and guidance, such as the 'Prevent' duty, by 18 December 2019

implement effective vetting and recruitment systems, in particular make sure checks are comprehensively explored and completed to help ensure staff's suitability, by 18 December 2019

On 18 December 2019 we received a written response from the provider who had taken the appropriate action to meet the notice to improve.

The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
