Summary of key findings

This provision meets requirements

- The childminder is confident in her responsibility to safeguard children effectively. She ensures her home is suitable for children to play safely and takes steps to minimise risks.
- The childminder reviews and evaluates her practice. She updates her training, researches ideas and actively seeks the views of parents to help her plan future improvements.
- The childminder explains how she shares key information with parents, such as policies and procedures.
- The childminder understands how to promote children's positive behaviour and develop their self-confidence. She promotes conversation and encourages children to develop a positive attitude to others.
- The childminder offers an inclusive service and promotes equality in her setting.
- The childminder considers the needs of children in her plans for the setting.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation.
