

Complaint about childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework-2.

If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 13 November 2019 we received concerns that this provider was not meeting some of these requirements.

We have served a notice to improve. This notice requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescale set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Actions needed by 24 December 2019:

ensure all reasonable steps are taken to prevent unauthorised persons entering the premises, this is in relation to the outside play area

ensure that person's whose suitability has not been checked do not have unsupervised contact with children

ensure the procedures set out in your safeguarding policy are implemented appropriately so that any safeguarding concerns about children are reported to the appropriate agency without delay

ensure all children have daily access to the outdoors

ensure any vehicles in which children are being transported are adequately insured.

The provider has responded appropriately to these actions.

The provider remains registered with Ofsted.

Publication of complaints
