

## **Compliance action taken for childcare provision**

### **Summary of outcome**

On 16 April 2019 the provider notified us of a safeguarding concern. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the early years foundation stage welfare requirements. All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at [www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2](http://www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2).

We visited the setting on 23 July 2019 to review how the setting meets the legal requirements, we served a Notice to Improve.

Action required by 27 August 2019;

follow your safeguarding policy, and have regard to the government's statutory guidance 'Working Together to Safeguard Children 2015, when referring information or concerns for children, or about adults, to other agencies.

We visited the provider on 28 August 2019 to monitor their compliance with meeting the above action. We are satisfied with the action taken.

The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

We met with the provider on 22 November and gathered further evidence about the action taken since August 2019. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

### **Publication of compliance action**

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
