

Complaint about childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 20 December 2019 we received concerns that this provider was not meeting some of these requirements. We identified that the provider had not ensured that aspects of their risk assessment procedures for the setting were in place.

We found that the provider had taken prompt and effective action to prevent a reoccurrence. The action taken was to:

■ Complete electrical safety testing on all equipment that required it, and put in place a procedure to maintain these checks for the future (Risk assessment).

We are satisfied with the action taken by the provider and no further action was required by Ofsted on this matter. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of complaints

We publish details of complaints made against childminders, home childcarers and childcare providers where we or the provider have taken action in order to meet legal requirements.

We publish details of complaints for five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
