Summary of key findings

This provision meets requirements

- The childminder understands how to build good relationships with schools and parents. She knows how to work together to develop a consistent approach to meet children's needs.
- The childminder recognises the importance of developing her skills and keeping up to date with new guidelines and requirements. For example, she has recently attended safeguarding training and keeps her knowledge current.
- The childminder plans to teach children about how to keep safe and be aware of their own personal safety. For example, she intends to teach them how to cross a road safely. She also intends to teach them to tidy up and be independent and to understand that small toys may be trip hazards if left discarded on the floor.
- The childminder has a good understanding of children's developmental and emotional needs. She intends to plan activities to motivate and interest each child.
- The childminder plans to reflect regularly on her practice and intends to seek the views of children and parents to help improve the quality of her setting.
- The childminder has a good understanding of how to promote and manage good behaviour. She plans to help children to understand their feelings and how to express them.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.
