

Complaint about childcare provision

Summary of outcome

'All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at

www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. On 17 December 2019 we received concerns that this provider was not meeting some of these requirements. We carried out a visit on 21 January 2020 and found breaches of requirements not related to the original concern. We have served a Notice to Improve. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the actions below by 5 February 2020. These notices to improve will be monitored.

ensure that children's bedding is stored appropriately to prevent cross contamination ensure that children's peg bags do not pose a risk to their safety

The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
