

## Compliance action taken for childcare provision

## **Summary of outcome**

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at <a href="https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2">www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2</a>. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 11 December 2019, the provider notified us that there had been a security incident at the setting. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the early years foundation stage welfare requirements to notify Ofsted of a significant event. The provider took appropriate action following the incident to ensure the setting was safe and secure. However, during the visit and not connected to the original concern, a breach of requirements was identified. We have served a Notice to Improve. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the action below within the timescales set out.

## Action required:

improve partnership working with parents to enable sensitive discussions about children and offer support to create continuity in their care, by 27 January 2020.

The provider responded promptly and appropriately to the notice.

The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.



## **Publication of compliance action**

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
